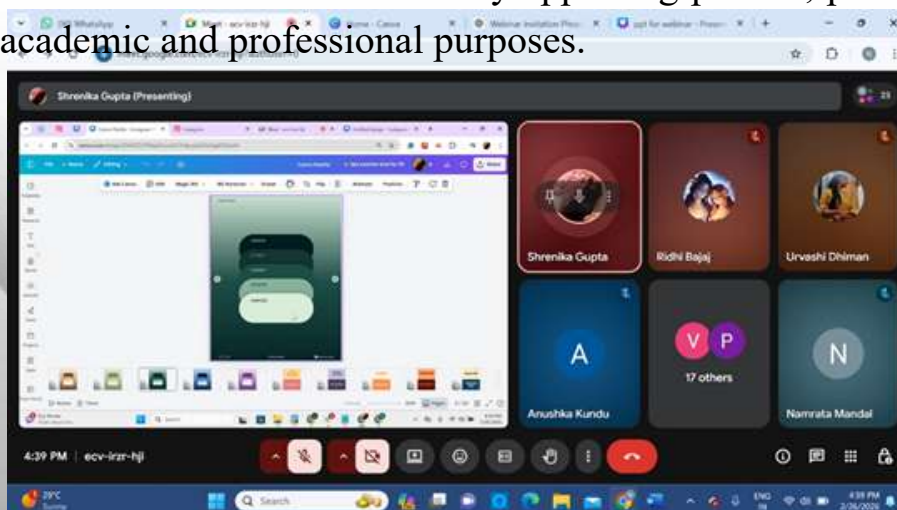
### AI as an emerging tool for learning

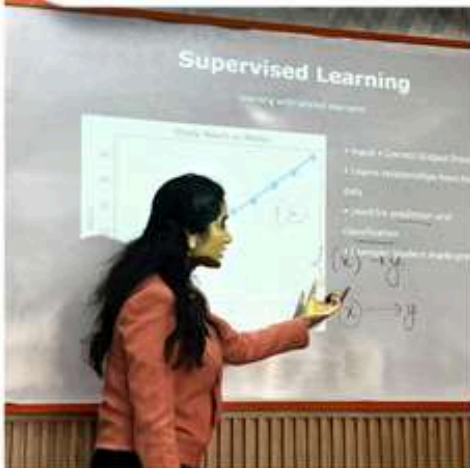

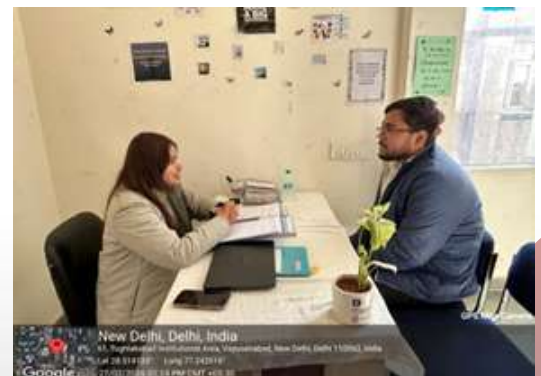
## Teacher Counselling Session

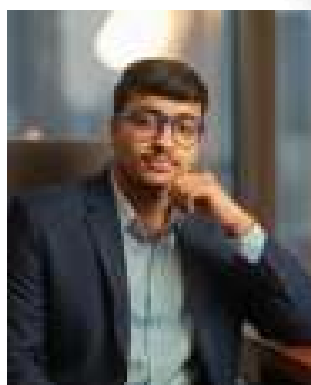

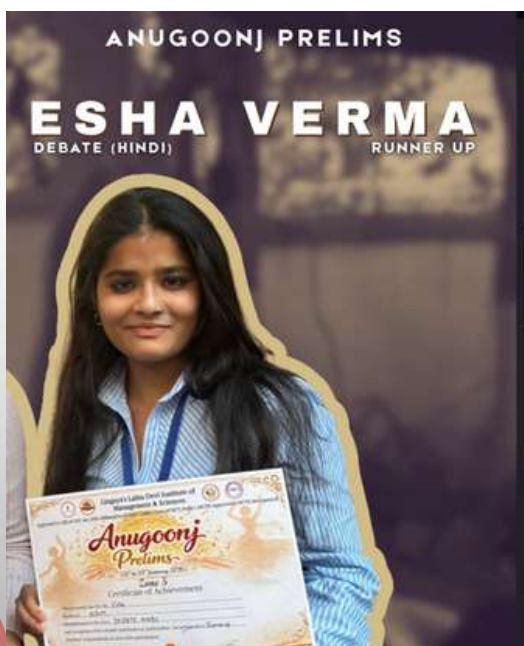
