

Student Welfare Department of NDIM organised Republic Day Celebration on 26th January, 2022 to celebrate the occasion of the 73rd Republic Day of India.


The event was conducted via zoom platform and multiple cultural performances were presented. It commenced with the hoisting of the Indian national flag followed by the National Anthem.


Various performances were prepared by the juniors as tribute to their seniors. There were grand arrangements for


Glimpse of students attending excel workshop

Basics of Research and Data Analytics Using Python 17th January, 2022 to 21st January, 2022




Soft skills of employees play an important as well as significant role in any organisation.



Investment Decisions and Tax Planning for Working Professionals 12 April 2022 to 14 April 2022


NDIM organised a 3 Day MDP on Investment Decisions and Tax Planning for Working Professionals from 12th April, 2022 to 14th April, 2022.


